



COVID VACCINATION UPDATE 27-01-2021 - message from Scott Ridley, Practice Manager.

Hughenden Valley Surgeries are happy to confirm that we are able to offer the AstraZeneca vaccine at our Chequers Drive site in Prestwood once again on Monday the 1st of February 2021.

We are thrilled to be able to offer the vaccine to our patients locally.

I can assure you that, as a team, we are working tirelessly to ensure safe & effective delivery of the vaccine and have been busy this week delivering vaccinations to housebound patients over the age of 80 in their homes.

By the end of the session on the 1st of February, we should have completed all of our group 1 and 2 patients and will then move on to our group 3 patients (Over 75's).

Our speed of delivery at the moment is based on vaccine delivery to our designated site in Chesham.

Vaccine deliveries are sent to our Chesham main site based on stock levels at the main distribution centres. When any vaccine arrives, our PCN group jumps into action and administers it without delay. Our number one priority is never to waste time or vaccine.

We will not be posting figures of how many remain to be vaccinated in each group, as we believe clock watching is not helpful to our patients and we do not wish to add more pressure to our workforce.
